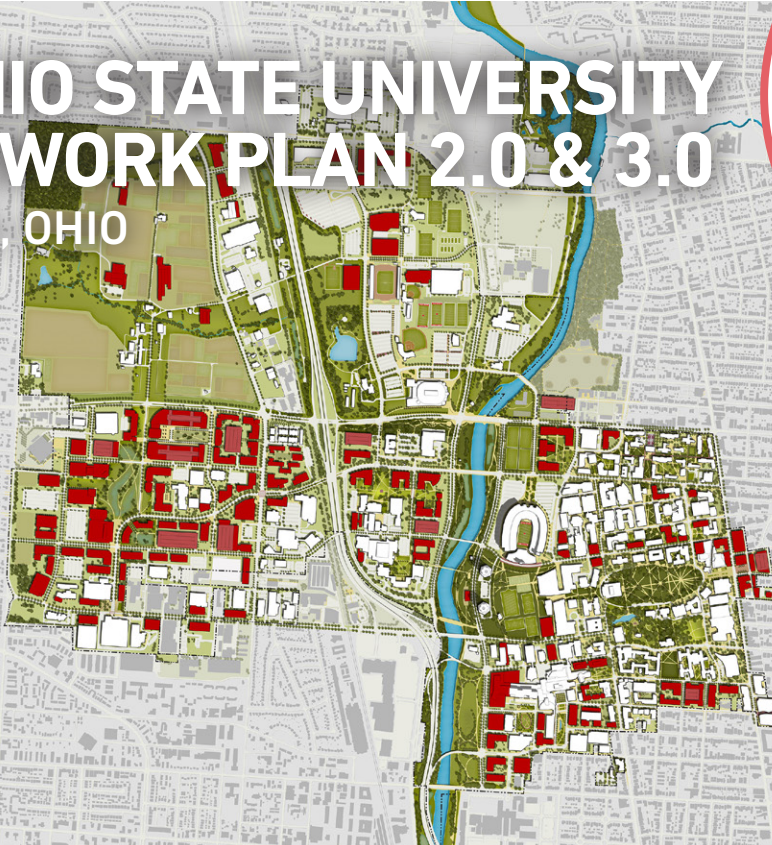

DESCRIPTION

The Ohio State University underwent an update to the 2010 One University Framework Plan as an opportunity to guide future campus capacity in the long-term, and identify solutions to near term campus challenges related to growth, facilities conditions, and programmatic needs while ensuring the strength and longevity of the OSU identity and brand.

OUR ROLE

MKSK was part of the Planning Team led by Ayers Saint Gross, focusing on updates to the physical planning of the campus building upon previous and current projects implemented since the initial Framework Plan. The Plan focuses on advancing the design for five district plans, focusing on scenarios for development in the following areas: Academic Core, Health Sciences, Residential Life, Partnerships, and Recreation.

IMPACT ON RAPID 5

Research and best practices were applied to create a physical plan focused on placemaking and connectivity. Coupled with a robust set of implementation strategies, the plan will establish a clear framework for the continued evolution of the campus, including its relationship to the Olentangy River.
